Re: *Tres Palacios Gas Storage LLC*, Docket No. CP23-3
Cavern 4 Expansion Project

On October 12, 2022, Tres Palacios Gas Storage LLC (“Tres Palacios”) filed an abbreviated application (“Application”) with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) for an amendment to its certificate of public convenience and necessity and abandonment authority pursuant to Sections 7(c) and 7(b), respectively, of the Natural Gas Act for authorization to expand the existing Tres Palacios natural gas storage facility in Matagorda County, Texas (the “Storage Facility”) and abandon an existing electric compressor.

Specifically, Tres Palacios is seeking: (i) an amendment to a 2007 certificate of public convenience and necessity to authorize Tres Palacios to expand its certificated natural gas storage capacity by converting and incorporating an existing third party brine production well (“Trull 11”) into an additional natural gas storage cavern (“Cavern 4”) at the Storage Facility that will add approximately 6.5 billion cubic feet (“Bcf”) of new working gas capacity and 3.5 Bcf of base gas capacity, including (a) surface development of the Trull 11 well pad site for Cavern 4, (b) a new approximately 0.6 mile, 16-inch bi-directional natural gas pipeline connecting Cavern 4 to the existing certificated facilities at the Storage Facility, (c) a new 5,500 horsepower (“hp”) electric motor driven, high discharge pressure, reciprocating compressor, and (d) a new 2.5 million British thermal units per hour (“MMBtu/hr”) dehydration unit; (ii) authorization to abandon in place an existing certificated 15,300 hp electric motor driven, low discharge pressure, centrifugal compressor (together with the addition of Cavern 4 and the appurtenant facilities, the “Expansion Project”); (iii) reaffirmation of its market-based rate authority; and (iv) related authorizations and waivers, as requested in the Application, and any other such waiver, authority, and further relief as may be necessary in order to grant the authorizations requested.

Tres Palacios has requested that the Commission issue an order on or before June 15, 2023, and construction would begin after Tres Palacios’ acceptance of the Commission’s order. Tres Palacios expects the requested construction and abandonment to be completed and the Expansion Project to be placed into service by December 2023. Tres Palacios has been in communication with all federal, state, and private landowners directly impacted by or abutting the Expansion Project, and will continue to work with the landowners as needed throughout the Expansion Project. Tres Palacios has acquired all easements and other land rights needed for the Expansion Project and will not need to utilize eminent domain for any portion of the Expansion Project.

Should your property be directly affected by the Expansion Project, a land representative of Tres Palacios will continue to be in contact with you as needed regarding the Expansion Project. As

mentioned above, Tres Palacios will not need to utilize eminent domain for any portion of the Expansion Project, however, anyone with concerns regarding the use of eminent domain can review the information at the Commission's website at www.ferc.gov or contact the Commission's Office of External Affairs at 202-502-8004.


